We were due to run the English Junior and Senior Open in May 2020 but due to changes imposed on us by the BJA, this event was cancelled. We were then very quiet until we finally were able to return to judo with the inaugural Breckland Senior Open in November 2021.

We have since been able to host the English Open for Pre-Cadet, Cadets, Junior and Seniors and very recently had the Eastern Area Low Grades competition.
