Program	Group 1	<p>Minimum age 8 years Under 12 years on the day Technical Restrictions will apply Maximum grade 6th Mon Players will be pooled on the day according to gender and weight All players will receive a medal</p>
Program	Group 2	<p>Minimum age 12 years Under 16 years on the day Maximum grade 12th Mon Players will be pooled on the day according to gender and weight All players will receive a medal</p>
Program	Group 3	<p>Senior Players over 15 years Maximum grade 2nd Kyu or 15th Mon Players will be pooled on the day according to gender and weight All players will receive a medal</p>
Competition Format, Rules and Judogi Rules	<p>Mat side coaching rule will be permitted throughout the event. One coach, who must remain seated is allowed per competitor.</p> <p>The wearing of white judogi is compulsory for this event; no blue judogi.</p> <p>Medals will be presented as soon as the group is completed, and the necessary paperwork is available.</p> <p>The decision of the Tournament Director will be final</p>
